Nigeria's livestock value chain is a major pillar of food security, rural employment, agribusiness investment, and animal protein supply. The sector covers poultry, cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, dairy, feed production, veterinary services, genetics, processing, cold chain, packaging, logistics, and retail markets.

With rising demand for meat, eggs, milk, and value-added animal protein products, Nigeria's livestock industry presents strong opportunities for technology providers, feed companies,

veterinary brands, equipment manufacturers, processors, distributors, investors, and development partners.

However, the sector still faces key challenges, including high feed costs, animal health risks, weak processing capacity, cold chain gaps, low productivity, and limited market structure. NIPOLI EXPO 2027 provides a strategic platform to connect these challenges with practical solutions, partnerships, and investment opportunities.



INDUSTRY FACTS

Nigeria has one of Africa's largest livestock markets, with strong demand across poultry, dairy, meat processing, feed, veterinary medicine, cold chain, and animal protein value chains. FAO data lists Nigeria's livestock population at about 55 million cattle, 139 million goats, 65 million sheep, and 685 million poultry birds.

Feed remains one of the biggest cost pressures in poultry production, accounting for about 70% of total poultry production cost. This creates major demand for feed ingredients, feed mills, nutrition solutions, and alternative feed innovation.

Nigeria is also Africa's largest egg producer, producing an estimated 533,000 metric tonnes annually, showing the scale and commercial importance of the poultry value chain. The dairy value chain also presents a major investment opportunity, with Nigeria spending over \$1.5 billion annually on milk imports while working to expand domestic production.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Exhibitors and Registrants (hereinafter also referred to as Applicants) shall be bound by the conditions, rules and regulations set forth in this agreement and any changes must be made in writing and signed by an authorized official of Cooman Events Management Services.
